


Catalina 30 Rudder Configurations



Mark I hull numbers from 1 through 4725 (design shaft length 30-1/2")

Mark II hull numbers from 4726 through 6249 (design shaft length: 20-3/8")

Mark III hull numbers from 6250 through the end of production (design shaft length is 21-5/8")

Although Catalina's drawing for the newer "Type A" rudder is dated April 1981, there is some information indicating that it may have been introduced as early as December of 1978.

Rudder shaft diameter: 2.355".

Note: The design shaft length is the length of the shaft in a perfect world. In reality they were made longer and then trimmed and drilled to fit the dimension required in order to fit the individual boat.

Caution! This information is anecdotal only. Always verify dimensions and shape (type A or B) against your old rudder before ordering.
